Ms. Bennett's Report: All county auditions October 8.

Mr. Heist Report: Getting ready for competition season. No competition on 10/13. Senior night will be 10/19.

Mrs. Fullerton's Report: Also getting ready for all county.

Band VP – Between 80-90% of marchers are paid. A discussion took place regarding wrapping the trailer and selling advertising space to cover the cost. Band VP's husband will recruit sponsors to cover cost of wrap and will update S. Michaud. T. Skorupa and Mr. Heist on progress.

Orchestra VP – still working on a potential "corporate" sponsor for Orchestra and Music Program.

Chorus VP – Working on getting Honors Chorus to do more events outside of school.

Color Guard VP – Bins are sorted (took longer than anticipated). Will be photographed and inventoried soon.

Secretary – Minutes from May 2, 2108 were distributed and upon motion made were unanimously approved.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer reported a general fund balance of \$7,158.69, a guitar fund of \$1,369.05, a student account balance of \$4,553.64 – noting that some students have graduated and she needs assistance in identifying those. The Marching Band fund currently has \$58,704.23 in it with most major expenses yet to come. The Penny Wars fundraiser over band camp raised \$1,709.15 and the Snap Raise fundraiser seems to be going well. It was noted that the more participants who fundraised, the higher percentage we received.

Fundraising – Need someone to organize restaurant nights. Claire's orders are due by 9/29. Working on a potential grocery store fundraiser.

Spirit Wear – Inventoried and ready to go for Bands by the Bay with some new merchandise.

Concert Attire – Really need volunteers for measuring and distribution and have a couple volunteers.
